Once your application has been received it will be acknowledged by the Membership Secretary. Please allow up to 10 days before receiving any further contact. Upon admission you will receive a Notice of Subscription which we would ask is settled within 7 days. The subscription year runs from 1 September to 31 August. If you are joining part way through the year you will be asked to pay the pro rata amount. Once your subscription has been paid you can start using the facilities.
